- All NCA Board Members are expected to announce any conflict, or appearance of a conflict of interest to fellow members.
- Any matter before a NCA Board Member which affects, or gives the appearance of affecting, a members' person or financial interest, or for which the member feels they cannot provide an objective decision, the member shall recuse themselves from all participation on the matter, including but not limited to debate, deliberations and voting.
- The minutes of any meeting of the NCA board or committee shall reflect that the conflict of interest was disclosed, that the interested person was not present during the final discussion or vote, and that the interested person did not vote.
- No NCA Board Member shall contact or speak directly to a resident, non-resident landowner, or a builder concerning an alleged violation of association policies, CC&Rs or by-laws. All Board of Directors' concerns and/or complaints with residents, non-resident landowners, or builders regarding alleged violations must be made to the NCA Office General Manager to be handled in the same manner as a complaint from any other property owner in Nanawale Estates.
